#### 2025 PARENT CONTRIBUTIONS

#### **SCHOOL SAVER BONUS**

As per previous correspondence every child in a Victorian government school will receive a once-off \$400 School Saving Bonus (SSB). This bonus can only be used towards uniforms, excursions, incursions, swimming programs and camp in 2025.


