SCHOOL PAYMENTS 2025

As detailed two weeks ago, just for 2025, there will be a new structure of parent payments. This is in response to a state government bonus payment to families of \$400 per student.

What happened up to now?

Normally parents pay for books and the excursion levy for a charge of \$240. Uniforms, swimming and excursions were billed separately and parents paid for them as they occurred.

What will happen now?

Parents will only pay the school for their student's books and classroom technology platforms. The voluntary levy is now only \$200 and you will order the books and they will be delivered to your home prior to the commencement of school next year. It is interesting to note that there are 200 days in a school year – it costs \$1 per day to come to school!!

Most people have received a link to the Parent Portal for the School Saving Bonus. You can go in after this coming Friday and allocate this to be dispersed. We suggest you allocate first: Excursions (school activities). \$80 Senior Sport Year 6 only \$60 Uniforms Swimming Camps

Each family will have different allocations. Maybe if you have a child in Prep – 2 and another in 3-6 you can combine the allocation to a greater amount for the older child's camp. It will help us if everyone allocates excursion and sport – then we will not need to separately invoice you every time the bus leaves for an activity. You can allocate right up to June 30th 2025. Need help? We are here for you.

SCHOOL SAVER BONUS UPDATE

The Victorian Government is delivering the School Saving Bonus – a one-off \$400 support for government school students from Prep to Year 12 in 2025. The School Saving Bonus will help families cover the cost of uniforms, textbooks, excursions, activities and more.

From Tuesday 26th November 2024, you will receive an email from the Department of Education with your unique \$400 School Saving Bonus code.

If you have multiple children enrolled in Victorian government schools for 2025, you will receive one School Saving Bonus code email per child. These emails might arrive on different days. Please make sure to check your spam/junk email folder.

Parents and carers can use the School Saving Bonus code in store at school-nominated suppliers. Parents and carers can also choose to access the School Saving Bonus online system, where they can allocate part or all the \$400 bonus to use at school nominated-online suppliers or for school activities.
