SECOND HAND UNIFORM SHOP

The Parents Association will be having a second-hand uniform sale this Thursday 20th February from 9:00am to 9:30am in the Canteen Foyer area at the back of the school. Please bring cash.

Parents are also reminded that when purchasing second hand uniforms to cross out any names on the item and replace it with your child's name, this way it will find its way back if lost. If you have any donations of uniform, please bring them to the office.

CAMP SPORT & EXCURSION FUND (CSEF)

A reminder to all families who are recipients of a government issued Health Care Card (not a Medicare card) that you need to complete an application form and submit your valid Health Care Card to the office for processing.

If you were in receipt of CSEF in 2024 and have had a prep child start at Serpell this year, please notify the office so they can be added to your family file. If you are approved for CSEF we will allocate the money received to Excursions, sport, swimming and camp as they arise.

SCHOOL SAVING BONUS (SSB)

For all eligible families that received the SSB (\$400 per child) you must log on to your portal to allocate your funds to either Uniforms or Activities.

Activities cover the following: Excursion / Incursion Levy (\$80 per student) Interschool Sport Levy (\$60 – year 6 only) Swimming (approx. \$70 per student) Camp (Year 3 to 6 and approx. \$250 to \$650)

What you need to know:

As 'Activities' arise within the school we will allocate your SSB (and CSEF if you are a recipient) amount you have chosen to be used for activities.

- 1. If the amount allocated does not cover the cost, you will see a balance amount on XUNO when you approve the event. You will need to pay this amount.
- If the amount allocated does cover the complete cost of the event, you will see a \$0.00 balance, you will still need to approve the event but will not be required to pay any additional amount.
- If you have chosen not to allocate any of your SSB to 'Activities' your child's event will be published on XUNO with the full amount owing.

CLASS REPRESENTATIVES

We are currently seeking parent volunteers to be Class Representatives for your child's class. This is a very special, valuable and important role that will not only enable you to become more involved with your child's class, but with the school community as a whole.

As a Class Rep all you need to do is to prepare and distribute your Class's Friendship List which will allow the class children and parents to keep in contact with each other. You are also encouraged to arrange at least one social activity per term.

Ideally, we need two class reps for each class, so this is perfect to do with a friend, as it is a very easy and rewarding role.
