#### **2025 NAPLAN EXCELLENCE**

The results of the 2025 Naplan for Years 3 and 5 in Reading, Writing, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation and Maths have been received by the school and we are once again delighted to share with parents that the levels of achievement are exceptionally high and consistent with the performance in previous years. Raw cohort scores may vary up or down by two or three points but with 194 Year 3 and 172 Year 5 students taking the test, the reliability of a Serpell education is confirmed by three-year trend data.

Individual results will be sent home in paper copy to parents on Friday. Individual performance may vary, and all student progress has been thoroughly reviewed. Students requiring tutoring have been placed in programs with Mrs Brunelli and Mrs Masik, with those students now demonstrating accelerated growth. If you are concerned about your child's Naplan result, the class teacher will be available to make an appointment to meet with you.

#### CHINA VISIT NEXT WEEK

Next Monday afternoon we are expecting the arrival of 34 students and 5 staff from the Suzhou Kunshan Yufeng Experimental School and the Lianyungang Jiefang Rd Primary School China. They will homestay with Year 6 families and experience a week of learning here at school. This is the first stage of our exchange program with China and I the final two weeks of this term we will have 64 students from Year 6 making the return visit to China. This program has been in place since 2011, when we commenced a sister school agreement with the Victorian and Jiangsu province school systems.
