This week we are excited to be hosting 34 students and 5 staff from China. Twelve of the students and two staff, including Principal Mr Sheng Qing, are from the Kunshan Yufeng Experimental Primary School, Suzhou, and twenty of the students and three staff, are from the Lianyungang Jiefang Rd Primary School. We are so excited to be able to welcome them and to share teaching and learning experiences together. The students are all home-staying with Serpell Year 6 families, and we are so grateful for this support. Tomorrow the group and their home stay buddies will attend a Victorian official welcome at the MCG, including a welcome reception, a tour of the MCG and lunch, with Primary and Secondary schools from across Victoria who are also participating in this exciting project. They have commenced their study tour in Sydney last week and will return to China after they leave us on Friday.

At the end of this term, we will have 64 students and 9 teachers making the return visit to China. They will visit Beijing, Nanjing, Lianyungang, Suzhou and Shanghai.
