We are looking forward to seeing all dads, grandfathers, uncles and their children at the Father's Day Breakfast this coming Friday morning. It will commence at 7am and run through until 8.45, when the students can show their families their classrooms. Come along in your favourite sporting colours — as simple as a scarf or tie to the full uniform. Prep Dads will have their very own tie made by the students for the event. There will be a photo booth as well as coffee and food delights. The students are always so excited to have their fathers at school. There is nothing that you need to do except maybe chat to other people wearing the same colours about the football finals or sporting heroes.

OFF TO CHINA NEXT WEEK

Next Tuesday morning sixty Year 6 students and nine teachers will fly to China for a two-week exchange experience of world-renowned tourist attractions and school life. First stop will be Beijing, where they will visit the Great Wall, the Forbidden City, Qianmen Street, the Temple of Heaven, the Science and Technology Museum and the Hutongs for some shopping. Next, they will travel via bullet train to Lianyungang, to reunite with the students who visited us here in July. They will also visit the Monkey King's hometown of Huaguo Mountain. Then they are off to Nanjing for the formal sister school event between the Jiangsu Education Bureau and the Victorian government and including primary and secondary schools from across Victoria. We are anticipating that very senior officials will be present at this dinner. The next day they will visit the Nanjing Confucius Temple and Laomendong before travelling again by bullet train to Suzhou. Here they will visit our sister school, the Jin Chang Foreign Language Experimental School and catch up with their buddies at the Kunshan Yufeng Experimental School. After a visit to the Suzhou Gardens and Ping Jiang Road, the group will travel to Shanghai by bus and visit Nanjing Road, Shanghai Market, the Bund for a Huangpu River Cruise and then finally an all-day experience at Disneyland before flying home.

For students with no Chinese background, this is a trip of huge cultural and linguistic learning and enrichment. For student with Chinese backgrounds, it is a deeply enriching opportunity to connect with the stories and language of their grandparents and be immersed in the history, language and culture of their ancestors.

Thank you to the teachers volunteering to support the program. It certainly is not a vacation, and we appreciate them giving of their personal and family time. Thank you also to the Jiangsu Education Bureau and the Victorian government for their ongoing and generous support of this program, which has been in place since 2011.

INFLUENZA A and B, COVID and RSV

At this time of year, we have higher rates of influenza A and B, covid and RSV in the community.

Symptoms:

Typically, symptoms are fever, cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, muscle or body aches, headaches, chills, and fatigue. Some people, especially children, may also experience vomiting and diarrhea.

Treatment:

Most people recover with rest, fluids, and over-the-counter medications to relieve symptoms. Antiviral medications may be prescribed in some cases, particularly for individuals at higher risk of complications, such as young children, the elderly, or those with underlying health conditions. It's important to consult a healthcare professional if symptoms worsen or do not improve.

Children must stay home until all symptoms have resolved.






