2025 PARENT OPINION SURVEY

All families will have received a link to the Parent Opinion Survey through Xuno. The survey remains open until the end of term and we would appreciate your help in completing it. The Department of Education publishes our data through the annual report and key strengths and opportunities for improvement are identified through this parent feedback. So far, we have sent out more than 900 invitations and have 50 returns. The survey is completely anonymous and translations in several languages are a feature of the survey.

OFF TO CHINA TODAY

This morning 60 very excited year 6 students and 9 teachers left for a 14-day experience tour of China and study days in schools in Lianyungang and Suzhou. First stop is Beijing, the Forbidden City, the Great Wall, the Science and Technology Museum and the Hutong by rickshaw. We will keep everyone informed of their travels through Xuno and next week's newsletter. We are very grateful to the Jiangsu Bureau of Education and the Victorian Centre for their support.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Research demonstrates that school attendance is really important for academic achievement. Our latest report for the Department shows that although school attendance overall at Serpell is very strong, we had 227 students with more than the average 12 days of absence for 2025. All the absences were explained, with many relating to holidays overseas. It is worth a thought when planning holidays to maybe match up with the school holidays when possible.

WHAT IS PYTHON?

Apparently, it is not just a snake. Python.Comp is an online programming competition for school students run by Grok Academy. Each week for 5 weeks, a set of Digital Technologies teaching resources are distributed to participants together with a set of questions testing this material. Participants submit their solutions to the Grok website where they are automatically marked.




