2025 JIANGSU INTERNATIONAL FORUM FOR SCHOOL PRINCIPALS

On Saturday I will fly to Nanjing for ten days with fourteen Victorian school principals, to attend the annual Jiangsu Victorian Principal Forum. This year marks the 20th anniversary of the partnership, and the meeting is held in Nanjing one year and Melbourne the other. Serpell has now been a part of this collaboration since 2011 and it has facilitated opportunities for student, staff and principal visits and learning across that time. The Forum runs for three days. After that I will be visiting our sister school in Suzhou, the Jin Chang Foreign Language Experimental School, and the other school that had students and staff visit us in July, the Suzhou Kunshan Yufeng Experimental School. I am so grateful for this opportunity which has allowed us to open the doors for our staff and hundreds of our students to experience a visit to China. On a larger stage, the program has built on the Australia China relationship and cooperation not just in education, but in the broader international context.

Book bags will be delivered to your home prior to the commencement of the 2026 school year.
