END OF YEAR TIMELINE

At this very busy time of the year, it is important to have a clear timeline of school events. The following is our lead up to the end of the year.

TUESDAY 9th DECEMBER - TRANSITION TO NEW CLASSES

At 10am on Tuesday 9th December, all classes will move to their 2026 classrooms and meet for an hour with their new classmates and teacher. The morning will involve getting to know you activities and helping the students to feel secure and confident about the next school year. Later that morning, we will Xuno the new class lists to parents. Parents can help by assisting their children in recognising not just their friendship list, but other classmates that they have known previously. Serpell children often feel anxious about change, so we have this arrangement in plenty of time for adjustment to take place.

MONDAY 15th DECEMBER – MEDAL PRESENTATION ASSEMBLY 9.30am

A special assembly for Years 2-6 will be held in the stadium on this morning to celebrate the academic and sporting achievements of students. ICAS medals, Science Talent Search awards, Australian Maths Competition, sporting awards and a raft of certificates will be presented to students. All parents and grandparents are most welcome. We are holding it in the morning, just in case the day is hot in the afternoon.

WEDNESDAY 17th DECEMBER - WHOLE SCHOOL XMAS ASSEMBLY 9.30am

2026 PARENT CONTRIBUTIONS

All families have now received their 2026 Parent Contribution Information paperwork.

- The contribution per child is \$200 which includes their authorised year level stationery supplies that are used in class (delivered to your home), online subscriptions used in class and classroom consumables for Art, Mathematics, English and Sport.
- Excursion/Incursion Levy (\$100 prep to 6). This
 payment covers all the excursions and incursions
 students participate in during the year and will be
 published on Xuno for payment in February.
- Senior School Sport Levy \$60 (year 6 only). This
 covers the bus transport for year 6 students
 participating in the Inter-school sport program in
 Semester 1. This amount will be published on
 Xuno for approval and payment in February 2026.
- Swimming and Camp are additional costs and will be published on Xuno for approval and payment at the time of the event.

Health Care Card (CSEF - Camp Sport & Excursion Fund)

- For those families who have a Health Care Card you are required to submit a new 2026 application along with your current Health Care Card. You can download the form from XUNO or pick up a paper copy from the office.
- The amount each child receives from the Government's CSEF has not been confirmed. This payment comes directly to the school and will be held in credit against your child's account for the duration of their time at Serpell until it is all used. It can only be debited against the Camps, Sport, Swimming and Excursions.

School Saving Bonus (SSB)

 The SSB was a one-off payment for 2025 by the State Government. Any unspent money will sit on your child's school finance account until it is all used up. As previously advised, this can only be used towards Excursions, camp and swimming. You can no longer use it to purchase uniforms.

Note: All families with a Health Care Card and/or left over SSB funds will have these amounts debited from the Excursion Levy, Senior Sport Levy (if applicable) and future swimming and camps until it is all used up. If you have an amount to pay, we have already deducted any unused funds from the amount.

Are you going away during the holidays?

Manningham SES and other emergency services can provide help if you need it, but you can make sure that you don't need us by taking steps to be prepared before you go away:

- Check the weather for any severe weather warnings or elevated Fire Danger Ratings before you go.
- Know how to describe where you are if you need to call for help.
- Consider packing an emergency kit with a portable charger / power bank to keep you connected.
- Choose camping sites that are under a clear sky. Never camp under trees or branches.
- Camp on higher ground away from creeks, rivers, streams, and other waterways.
- Set a watch zone to include your camp location on the Vic Emergency app so you receive warnings.
- If visiting national parks or walking tracks, check with Parks Victoria via parkweb.vic.gov.au ahead of time for closures
